A 10-week training course to experience a European writers room and develop collaborative writing skills.

The participants develop an original series concept in groups advised by series professionals.

PART 1

Serial Dramaturgy; European Series Markets; Characters & Conflicts; How to Develop a Season & Pilot.

PART 2

Mentoring; Moodboard; Case Studies; Masterclasses.

PART 3

How to Write Greener Series; Negotiation and Contracts; Pitch Deck; How to Pitch.

REQUIREMENTS

 Have already written a script (TV series, online series, short film or feature film), whether or not it has been produced.

- Have over 18 years old or above
- Have the desire to work in Europe in their professional future
- Have the nationality or a long-term residence permit from one of the following countries

- June 26, 2024: Deadline for posting videos on the EUREKA SERIES private online community
- July 1-2-3, 2024: Online video interviews with pre-selected applicants

- From September 24 to December 6, 2024: EUREKA SERIES training program

TUITION FEES

APPLICATION PROCESS 2 STEPS




An application form online, with the following mandatory documents to be provided in English:

- Copy of your national ID or passport
- Headshot

- A short presentation video to be posted on the Eureka Series private online community (details will be sent to pre-selected applicants alongwith the results)
- Online interview with the pedagogical team
