In groups, they create and develop original series concepts, which they present during a final pitch. Apollo Series is a program designed and developed by Series Mania Institute in partnership with MIA | Mercato Internazionale Audiovisivo and Göteborg Film Festival's TV Drama Vision.

This training program helps emerging European producers strengthen their series projects by mastering the legal, financial, and artistic aspects of European co-productions, while offering access to key industry events. It will take place over three sessions:

- The first session in Rome (Italy) at MIA | Mercato Internazionale Audiovisivo in October 2025
- The second session in Gothenburg (Sweden) at Göteborg Film Festival's TV Drama Vision in January 2026
- The final session in Lille (France) at Séries Mania Forum in March 2026

Series Mania Institute develops the 'Serial Bridges' workshops around the world for professionals at the request of local and/or international partners. This initiative aims to give participants a good understanding of the international series market and, more specifically practical advice on how to better understand the European co-production and co-financing market.

SERIAL BRIDGES : ASIA

In partnership with TAICCA

SERIAL BRIDGES : ISTANBUL

The workshop is organized in partnership with the Institut Francais Turkey and m2 Film Lab.

PARTICIPANTS

Duos writer/producer pairs from Turkey, Georgia or Azerbaijan with a series project

PROGRAM

In pairs, the participants will be guided for five days by two mentors, in group and individual meetings. They will also have the opportunity to meet renowned international series professionals during exclusive masterclasses.

OBJECTIVES

The program aims to give participants a good understanding of the international series market and, more specifically, practical advice on how to apprehend the European co-production and co-financing market better.



SERIAL BRIDGES : RIO DE JANEIRO

The workshop is organized with the support of RioFilme, a public company linked to the Municipal Secretary of Culture, Projeto Paradiso, Rio Film Festival, SICAV, FIRJAN, and the French Embassy in Brazil.

PARTICIPANTS

Brazilian producer/showrunner pairs with a series project.

PROGRAM

A five-day intensive program, starting with a focus on the dramaturgical aspects of series projects, and gradually adding economic and production notions, culminating in a final pitch session.

OBJECTIVES

Strengthen dramaturgical skills, understand the international financing systems and develop the participants' ability to find coproduction opportunities

OBJECTIVES

- Provide students the necessary tools and expertise to understand the ever-evolving landscape of image arts.
- Making them more professional, thanks to a second year of apprenticeship, students are prepared to enter the workforce upon receiving their diploma.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students with a bachelor's degree (180 ECTS credits).

PROGRAM

2-year course to educate students for various audiovisual professions both in France and internationally, encompassing fields such as digital (platforms, streaming or digital distribution), television, and cinema.

SCHEDULE

Two years of the Master's program, at school and alternating between school and work.

SEMESTRE 1

Sociology of TV series, history of film and audiovisual industries, international series ecosystems, etc.

SEMESTRE 2

Case studies, audiovisual writing courses, Series Mania Festival & Forum, etc.

SEMESTRE 3 & 4

Case study on the mini-series created by the Tremplin program (distribution strategy, broadcasting).


