At the end of the training, each group pitches its original series concept at the Final Presentation, assessed by a professional panel.

PRODUCTION ACCOUNTING



The new training program in Production Accounting is aligned with the needs of the serial industry and the proliferation of international projects shot in France, especially in the Hauts-de-France region.

A production accountant manages the financial, social and fiscal administration of an audiovisual production. They ensure compliance with legislation on shooting locations throughout the project's duration. This is a critical role from pre-production to post-production.

French-speaking production assistants, post-production assistants, accountants

MASTER "MANAGEMENT DES MÉTIERS DE L'IMAGE" BY SCIENCES PO LILLE



An international program that provides the knowledge needed to navigate the contemporary challenges in the field of image professions.



OBJECTIVES

- Provide students the necessary tools and expertise to understand the everevolving landscape of image arts.
- Making them more professional, thanks to a second year of apprenticeship, students are prepared to enter the workforce upon receiving their diploma.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students with a bachelor's degree (180 ECTS credits).

PROGRAM

2-year course to educate students for various audiovisual professions both in France and internationally, encompassing fields such as digital (platforms, streaming or digital distribution), television, and cinema.

SCHEDULE

Two years of the Master's program, at school and alternating between school and work. Starting in September 2024.

SEMESTER 1

Sociology of TV series, history of film and audiovisual industries, international series ecosystems, etc.

SEMESTER 2

Case studies, audiovisual writing courses, Series Mania Festival & Forum, etc.

SEMESTER 3 & 4

Case study on the mini-series created by the Tremplin program (distribution strategy, broadcasting).

A program for young people in Hautsde-France that introduces them to narrative techniques and technical professions in the French audiovisual industry.

WHO CAN APPLY?

18-25 year-olds from the Hauts-de-France region (20 participants per year) willing to work in the audiovisual industry.

OBJECTIVES

Acquire and develop knowledge and skills in the audiovisual, serial and digital media professions.

Integrate the industry through entry-level jobs.

EACH PROFESSION IS APPROACHED THROUGH PRACTICE

Screenwriting, Directing, Editing, Sound, Production

Please note that our training programs are not eligible for CPF.

ARTISTS AND AUTHORS

Training rights managed by AFDAS.

Eligibility requirements: You must be able to justify €6,990 in cumulative income as an artist-author over the last three years (excluding the current year) or €10,485 in income over the last five years (excluding the current year). These conditions allow artists and authors to benefit from an annual budget of €5,600 excluding tax to finance one or more training actions (amount for 2024).

▶ INTERMITTENT PERFORMERS

Training rights managed by AFDAS.

Eligibility requirements: You must be able to justify a minimum level of activity as an intermittent worker over several years. Please refer to the detailed conditions here.

▶ EMPLOYEES ON FIXED-TERM OR PERMANENT CONTRACTS

The Skills Development Plan refers to all training actions implemented by the employer for their employees. Your employer can therefore cover the costs of your training, either directly or more generally through the OPCO to which they belong (depending on the sector).

Please consult with your employer or your organization's human resources department.

FOR INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANTS

We encourage you to contact local funds or writer/producer guilds/federations to inquire about potential funding.








